He was one of the principal architects of the modern, nonviolent civil rights movement and a key mentor to Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. King carried <u>Jesus and the</u> <u>Disinherited</u>, Thurmans' most important book, while leading the 1955-56 Montgomery bus boycott. Thurman, an African American, was an author, philosopher, theologian, educator and civil rights leader.
