BRING TO YOUR WORSHIP SPACE:

- a candle and matches
- a substance for anointing
 - OIL. Small amount of olive oil, canola oil... whatever you have. Put in a small bowl next to your candle.
 - **WATER.** A bit of water in a small bowl.
 - ASHES. You may want to write down on paper things you would like to let go of: fear, anger, etc., and then burn the paper. Put the ashes in a little bowl and have them ready. (Safety note: If your ashes need a bit of moisture in them, only use oil to moisten rather than water. Ashes + water = a caustic substance called lye.)
 - DIRT. The Ash Wednesday service reminds us that we were made of dust and to dust we will return. A small bowl of dirt, perhaps moistened with water, will be great.
