Words for Meditation - from First Nations Version: An Indigenous Translation of the New Testament *

At the end of the day, the headman said to his manager, "Bring the workers in from the field and pay them, beginning from last to first." He paid the workers hired at the end of the day a full day's wage. When the workers who were hired at the start of the day were paid, they expected to receive more but were paid the same amount.

"We have worked all day in the scorching heat," they complained to the manager. "Why should we be paid the same as the ones who worked only one hour?"

"I am not being unfair with you, my friend," he said to one of them. "Did we not agree on the amount of a full day's wages? Take your payment and go in peace. If I want to pay these men the same, what is that to you? Am I not permitted to be generous with what is mine? Or are you jealous because I have done a good thing?" (Mt. 20:8-16)
