Lola Beth Goering Ediger

January 23, 1930 - May 19, 2023

Lola Beth was born to Christian Samuel and Maria Frances (Kaufman) Goering, on January 23, 1930 in Moundridge KS. Along with 5 siblings, she was raised on a dairy farm and learned a strong work ethic, value, health, spirituality, and peacekeeping.

She was a graduate of Moundridge High School and Bethel College Deaconess Hospital School of Nursing (1951). On October 7, 1951 Lola married Raymond Stanley Ediger. They celebrated 57 years of marriage before his death on December 12, 2008.

Her career included over 50 years as a registered nurse. In 1997 Lola and Ray purchased a 3-story house on Main Street in Hutchinson and operated the Wrought Iron Inn Bed and Breakfast until 2005. Lola was a master baker known for grinding Turkey Red Wheat for her delicious Zwiebach and cinnamon rolls. She was an accomplished seamstress, gardener, sports fan and practical joker. She generously donated her time and talents to Mennonite Central Committee, Mennonite Disaster Service and 4-H Club. The Kansas MCC Sale was an annual highlight and she served on the Board for many years. Lola had a profound influence on many people throughout her life.

Lola lived in Santa Fe NM at the time of her death.
