Come in the center aisle to one of the stations in the front to receive bread and juice. If you prefer to remain seated, a server will come to you. In keeping with our Anabaptist tradition, we offer those still making a decision about baptism (often children and youth) a bunch of grapes and a blessing. However, as this is God's Table and not ours, we invite you to participate as you feel led by the Spirit of the Living Christ, the true host. All seeking to know and follow Christ more fully are welcome.

Today, between receiving bread and drinking the cup, you are invited to pause to sanitize your hands as a symbol of purification, signifying our desire to turn away from the ways of the kingdoms of this world and commit to the kingdom of God.
