NEW OPPORTUNITIES for CREATION CARE:

- 1. MCC in North Newton is recycling soft plastics (plastic bags, bread bags, any plastic packaging that you can stretch). Plastics must be clean, dry and free of food waste. A basket under the table in the foyer at FMC is designated to receive your recyclables.
- **2.** Recycle e-waste at Sanford's Computer Works in Hutchinson! Recycled electronics are: *cell phones, I-pads, computers, calculators, power activated tools with batteries (building tools, garden tools), stereo systems, DVD players, video game players, <u>flat screen</u> TV's, <i>microwaves.* Take your items to Sanford's Computer Works at 20 S. Main (open Monday-Friday 9am-6pm) where they will be taken apart, recycled, and reused.
