Kintsukuroi: The broken vessel is often more beautiful than the original.

The Japanese tradition of kintsukuroi creates (or recreates) pottery from broken pieces. Damaged vessels are put back together, often with gold binding, to create a useful object once again. The new piece tells a story about the past and is infused with glory that is greater than the former, as in Haggai 2:9.
