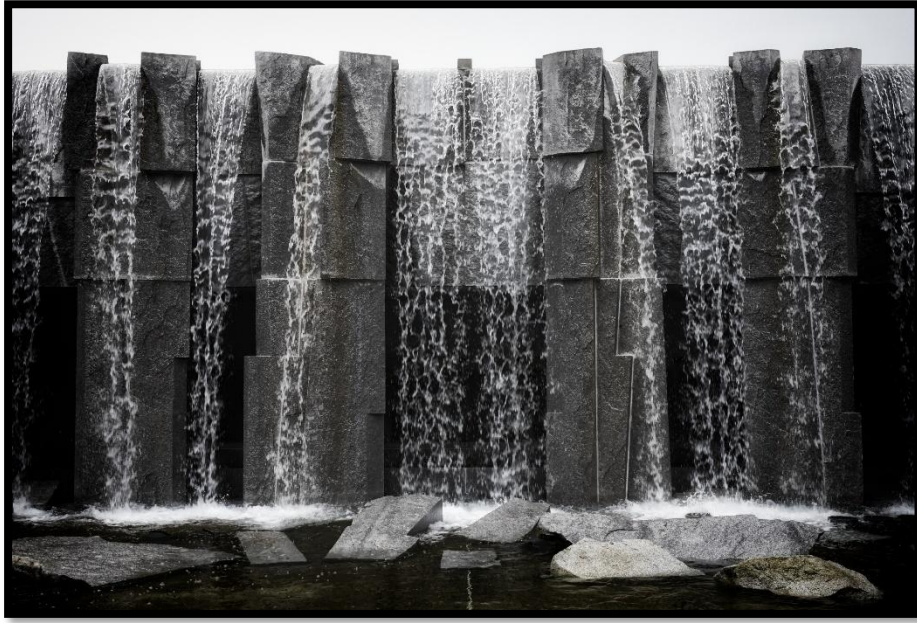

ADDRESSING INCREASED HUNGER IN RENO COUNTY

Ending hunger in Reno County isn't a job for one church or one organization – it requires all of us working together. **On Nov 19 from 5-7pm 21 area churches will 'leave their lights on' while collecting donations of non-perishable food for the Food Bank of Reno County.** *The Food Bank of Reno County suggests these items: pasta, peanut butter, mac&cheese, cereal, canned meats, vegetables, fruits, and canned soups.*
