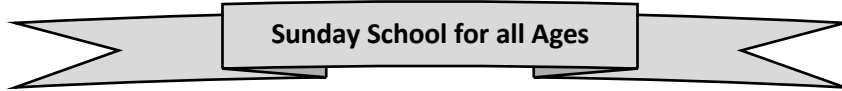
Fellowship time with drinks after worship in Common Grounds Room
